Vetsense Weight-Loss Paste is a targeted nutritional supplement for dogs and cats, combining Taurine to support cardiovascular health, fish oil for optimal metabolism and coat quality, L-Carnitine to enhance fat utilisation, and Conjugated Linoleic Acid (CLA) to promote lean body mass. Designed to aid in safe, effective weight reduction while supporting overall wellness.

Combining Taurine & L-Carnitine in a weight-loss product may have several potential benefits:

- ✓ **Improved Energy/Fat Utilisation** - May aid in preventing excess calories from being stored as fat.
- ✓ **Support for Lean Muscle Mass** - Important for maintaining your pet's overall health and mobility.

KEY INGREDIENTS:

L-Carnitine

Involved in the transportation of fatty acids into the mitochondria, the energy-producing centres of cells. By aiding in the utilisation of fats for energy, L-Carnitine may help the body burn fat more effectively and may contribute to muscle preservation during weight loss, as it helps the body use fat for energy, potentially sparing muscle tissue.

Taurine

Essential amino acid for dogs & cats, particularly for certain breeds. It plays a vital role in various bodily functions, including bile salt formation, eye health, and cardiovascular function. Taurine may help regulate metabolism by supporting the conversion of nutrients into energy. This can contribute to maintaining a healthy weight by ensuring efficient energy utilisation.

Fish Oil

Rich in Omega-3 fatty acids, specifically eicosapentaenoic acid (EPA) and docosahexaenoic acid (DHA). These fatty acids offer various health benefits, including anti-inflammatory properties, which can be beneficial for dogs with conditions that may contribute to weight gain, such as arthritis. Reducing inflammation may improve overall mobility and encourage more physical activity.

Conjugated Linoleic Acid (CLA)

CLA is a type of fatty acid that may help with the metabolism of fats. It can potentially enhance the body's ability to burn fat for energy. Like L-Carnitine, CLA has been suggested to help preserve lean muscle mass during weight loss, contributing to a healthier body composition.

FAQs

How does it work?

- ✓ L-Carnitine has been shown to promote weight loss in dogs & cats.
- ✓ Taurine is required for vision and cardiac function, it also plays a key role in the nervous and immune systems. Please note Taurine requirements are increased with high-fibre diets.
- ✓ Fish oil can assist weight-loss efforts by improving cellular energy metabolism.
- ✓ Conjugated Linoleic Acid (CLA) has been shown to reduce weight gain & reduce fat deposition, while maintaining lean body condition.

What diet should I feed my pet?

Vetsense Weight-Loss Paste should be used with a diet that is complete and balanced. This is most easily achieved by using a commercial pet food diet. For the quickest results, Vetsense Weight-Loss Paste can be combined with a commercial diet that is designed for weight loss or weight management. Your veterinarian or pet retail assistant will be able to recommend an ideal weight-management diet.

What about home cooked or raw diets?

Vetsense Weight-Loss Paste can be used in conjunction with home cooked or raw food diets. The main consideration is still to ensure that the diet is complete & balanced. Ensuring all nutrient and micronutrient requirements are met and correctly balanced can be difficult and individual consultation with a veterinarian or animal nutritionist may be required.

How do I give Vetsense Weight-Loss Paste? Will my pet like it?

Vetsense Weight-Loss Paste is highly palatable, and most pets enjoy the fishy flavour. The once daily dose can be mixed with your pet's food or administered as directed by your veterinarian.

How quickly should weight loss occur?

The optimal weight-loss rate is generally considered to be 1 – 2% of bodyweight per week for dogs and 0.5 – 1% of bodyweight per week for cats. This means that most pets should reach their weight-loss goals within 6 – 8 months.

How should I monitor my pet's weight loss?

Pets undertaking a weight-loss program should be weighed every 2-4 weeks. If the weight-loss rate is slower or faster than expected, some aspect of the program needs to be adjusted. This may include the daily calorie intake, the composition of the diet or the pet's activity levels. In some cases, Vetsense Weight-Loss Paste may work so efficiently that your pet may only need a short course of this supplement. Please consult your veterinarian for further advice.
